#### The Five Causes


**Final Cause:** that for the sake of which.

Paradigmatic Cause: that in relation to which.

**Efficient Cause:** that by which.

Formal Cause: that in which.

Material Cause: that from which.



#### Five Causes... of a Statue

Final Cause: its purpose.

Paradigmatic Cause: the model.

**Efficient Cause:** the craftsman

(or, the act of

bronze-casting)

Formal Cause: its form/shape.

**Material Cause:** (the) bronze.

#### Five Causes... of a House

**Final Cause:** shelter, etc.


Paradigmatic Cause: the (mental) "blueprint."

**Efficient Cause:** the carpenter

(or, the act of building)

Formal Cause: the arrangement of parts.

Material Cause: the bricks, wood, etc.

Sometimes, the form falls short of the paradigm...



#### Five Causes... of a Heart


**Final Cause:** circulating blood.

Paradigmatic Cause: an ideal configuration.

**Efficient Cause:** 

Formal Cause: its form/shape.

Material Cause: the cells, tissues, etc.



## Five Causes... of a Human Being

**Final Cause:** the human good.

Paradigmatic Cause: an ideal paradigm.

Efficient Cause: human parents.

Formal Cause: a soul (principle of self-motion

& self-organization).

Material Cause: various constituent parts.

#### Five Causes... of the Cosmos

Final Cause: Goodness/"the Good."

Paradigmatic Cause: divine ideas.

**Efficient Cause:** the Demiurge ("craftsman")

(whose activity is inseparable

from himself)

Formal Cause: the World-Soul (principle of

self-motion & self-organization)

Material Cause: matter.

(on a basic reading of Plato's *Timaeus*)

## Six Causes... of a Platonic Dialogue

**Final Cause:** the good.

Paradigmatic Cause: the problem.

**Efficient Cause:** the soul.

**Instrumental Cause:** the arguments.

Formal Cause: its style.


Material Cause: characters

and setting.





## Synchronic vs. Diachronic




Synchronic: at the same time

Diachronic: across time(s)




#### Synchronic vs. Diachronic




Synchronic: at the same time

## Temporal vs. Eternal




- Temporal: within the flow of time; in some/all frames.
- Sempiternal: at <u>all</u> times; in every frame.
- Eternal (in the strict sense): <u>outside</u> of time; not in the frames.

## The Five Causes: Time & Eternity

## Inherence Causes


• The <u>parts</u> are the causes of the <u>whole</u>.



#### Inherence Causes


• The <u>substance</u> is the cause of its <u>properties</u>.

(It needs to be there "first!")



#### Non-Inherence Causes

• Properties of the parts cause the properties of the whole.
